NANOYOU aims for health, it is a project funded by the 7th Framework Programme of the European Commission that aims to increase young people's basic understanding of nanotechnology (NT) and to engage them in the development of their ethical, legal and social aspects (ELSA). It also aims to encourage scientific research amongst European youth and promote their engagement in NT as a career when their opportunities are emerging.

With the goal of a multidisciplinary and practical approach, NANOYOU facilitates participatory international cooperation on nanotechnology with a European dimension among schools, universities and training centres in more than 20 countries.



A participatory gate to nanotechnology



The multidisciplinary participatory projects work and games, virtual experiments or debates together with other educational, teaching or scientific centres for greater involvement in NT. It also offers a quantity of working materials on NT education developed by other institutions outside the European continent.



A strong European schools programme

NANOYOU offers lesson modules and One Day Events (Open Days for schools) to be carried out in their schools. At all, throughout the 10th month, activities will be held.

Teachers will also be provided with training to be better able about NT and to guide them in the context of the school programme. This includes background materials, resources and specific case studies together with experiments that can be done in the classroom in facilities within NT aspects.



Outreach in European Science Centres

NANOYOU will develop an activities on nanotechnology that will be carried out in European Science Centres and Institutes. Several workshops dealing with nanotechnology and NT will be carried out in European Science Centres in regular programmes. They will include work plans in 10 and 20 minutes. The results of these workshops will be discussed in conferences with reports and publications.
