



Established in 1990 and located in Vienna, the [Centre for Social Innovation](#) (ZSI) is a non-profit and politically independent research institute, which asserts thematic leadership throughout Europe towards growth in social innovation and the promotion of an overt and solidly united society.



ZSI is divided into three core areas: work and equal opportunities, technology and knowledge, and research policy and development.
