

NANO - Memory Game

Terms and Definitions – Basic Knowledge

Object of the Game:

To know the basic terms and definitions of nanoscience and nanotechnology

Procedure:

Match each term with the correct definition (description).

How To Play:

- Spread out the whole set of cards (16 cards) face down.
- Select two cards at random.
- If the two cards match, these cards will be removed and you score 1 point – now select another two cards
- If the two cards don't match, replace them face down and another member of the group will take his chance
- The person who has the most pairs wins the game

Note:

try to remember the location and what is on the card so you can find matching cards and win.

Teacher's instructions:

after all the groups have finished playing, gather all class members together and ask questions related to the terms mentioned in the different memory game sections.
